

## **Health & Safety Policy**

A A Waste is committed to ensuring that the necessary procedures exist within its business to maintain, as far as reasonably practical, the Health and Safety of all its employees and others who may be affected by the Company's activities.

This responsibility shall be discharged through the creation of an effective management system with clearly defined areas of responsibility residing with competent personnel. We also value the experience of our staff and will communicate and co-operate with our employees and outside agencies to constantly improve our performance in this area. Where necessary skills or qualifications do not exist within the business we the Company will employ external specialists.

A proactive approach will be taken to Risk Assessment and all employees within the business will, where possible, be encouraged to contribute to the best working practices in support of this policy the Company will make available facilities, training and other resources which will aid its employees in carrying out the Companies legal duties.

The Company will provide all customers and employees with Material Safety Data Sheets conforming to the Control Of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) 2002 regulations to ensure all persons using hazardous substances are fully aware of the risk involved.

The Company will ensure that every employee is informed of their legal duty to take reasonable care of their own health and safety and that of others. The ultimate responsibility for Health and Safety rests with the Partners of A A Waste but it is the duty of all company employees to ensure that their working environment is as safe as possible.

A A Waste welcomes any employee with ideas on improving the Health and Safety regime within the Company to contact either one of the Partners their ideas will then be assessed and, if found to be practicable, will be included in the Company Health and Safety Policy.
